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Mr. Harold W. Haase of Spring Lake, a lifelong resident of West Michigan, passed away on Monday, August 10, 2026 at the age of 94.

Harold was born on May 3, 1932, in Muskegon, Michigan, to Arthur and Winifred (Sikkenga) Haase. He attended Muskegon High School and on the first day of his senior year, September 6, 1949, he met the love of his life, Elaine Johnson. The two were married on May 4, 1951, in Muskegon and shared nearly 70 years of marriage together.

Harold first worked as a buyer for Homer Haydens during the early 1950s and began working for Consumers Energy at the B.C. Cobb Plant, transferring to J.H. Cambell Plant when it opened in 1963 and was there until his retirement in 1991.

Harold had a lifelong love of golf and especially enjoyed playing alongside Elaine. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Elaine Haase; grandson, Aaron Haase; parents, Arthur and Winifred (Sikkenga) Haase; sisters, Eleanor Veurink and Arlaine Marcil; and brother, Eugene Haase. Harold is survived by his sons, Arthur (Cris) Haase, Douglas (Kathy) Haase, and Jeffery (Jennifer) Haase; six grandchildren; twelve great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren; and many extended family members and friends.

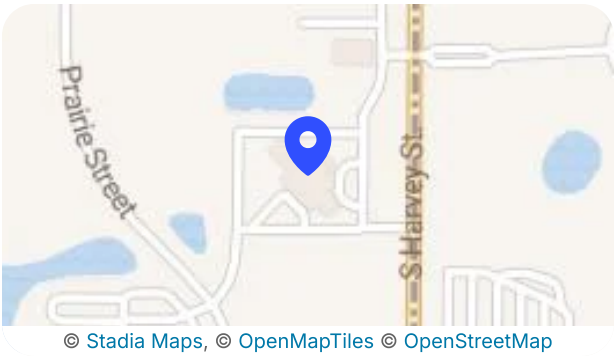

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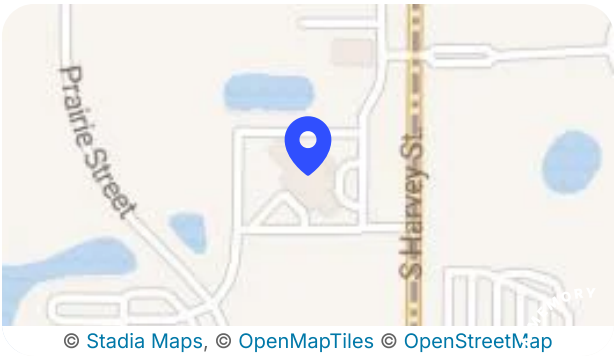

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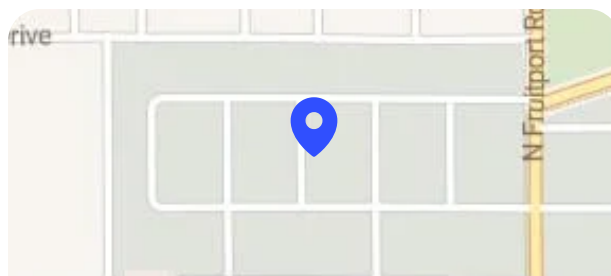
